- Charoseth – a mixture of apples, nuts and wine

Cloth (to wrap the Afikomen)

Sweets to reward the children with

Grape Juice / Wine

Elijah's cup and setting

Haroseth Recipe (make same day or day before and seal)

- 1 Apple
- 1 Cup chopped nuts
- 1 Cup chopped dried fruit
- ½ Teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 Teaspoon honey
- 1 – 3 Teaspoons sweet red wine
